



Bangkirai The color of Bangkirai is a wheat-brown, a color it retains after being cut. The surface of Bangkirai alternates from smooth to rough textures due to the interlocked nature of the grain. There are strong variations in color however, which are well suited to decking material. When exposed to the elements, Bangkirai, like many other tropical timbers, grevs very quickly greys very quickly

Bangkirai is mainly used for heavy duty structures such as for bridges, railway sleepers, floors and for post and beam Bangkirai houses. A growing market for this wood is being found in terrace and patio flooring as well garden furniture.
